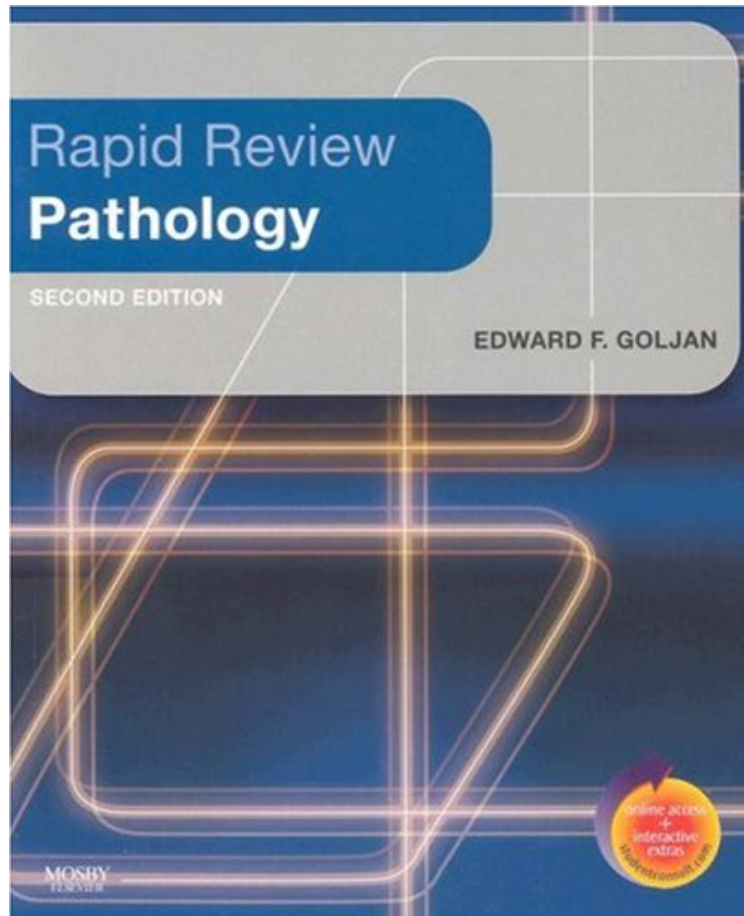

The author should not be included in the Rapid Review series. He might as well just publish a review book titled "Goljan's Review of Pathology". The tables and boxes are highly dense with text. Pathology is a big topic and I don't blame the guy for trying to include as much information as he can. But I do not believe that Goljan is a "Rapid" way of reviewing this topic. I'm sure this is a very great comprehensive review. Everything in Step 1 will be covered in this book, but you need to ask yourself... "Is everything in this book covered in Step 1?" There is way too much unnecessary information for Step 1. I believe this book is a comprehensive review for both Step 1 and 2. An example is in the section of Vascular Disorders, he lists clinically important serum Triglyceride levels. You don't need to know that information until you're on clinical rotations, which is covered in Step 2. Seriously!
