I received this rental and it was obviously a used book... no big deal as the content was the same and the book still usable. When I sent the book back they rejected it as "damaged" and then charged me \$124.00 for it (even though a NEW book is only \$88.00 on)!! I returned the book in the same condition as I received it so I am obviously very upset about the alleged "damage" that I did not create. Additionally, the student code on the inside of the book was already peeled and used when I got the book even though it was advertised as being included. This is not a big deal as I don't use these types of access but it was just another misrepresentation that I should have somehow reported when I received the book. BEWARE of this rental scam and return the book immediately if there is any sign of damage or wear that they could possibly blame on you!!!!44 of 45 people found the following review helpful. Buy Student ConsultBy depaulRobbins is great. The new edition is great. "Expert Consult" is a total waste of money however. As far as I can tell, I paid about 10 extra dollars to get a black cover. The text inside is exactly the same. The online

features are exactly the same; in fact, I had to contact the publisher several times via email just to get my "expert consult" online access activated because the code that came in my copy of the book was incorrectly coded for Student Consult access. Now, I am thinking I might as well not have bothered; not only was it an unnecessary extra expense for the same services, but also: no other textbook you will buy uses the "expert consult" website, while many of them use Student Consult (Gray's Anatomy for Students, Goljan Path, Costanzo Phys), so now I just have one more account and website that I have to log in to. 6 of 6 people found the following review helpful. By Rithvik Balakrishnan I bought Robbins for my Kindle after it became apparent to me just how important it would be for my 2nd year curriculum, and after a few painful days biking to school with the behemoth hard copy in my back pack. I really appreciate being able to access all of the Robbins information in such a small (and light!) package, but I think it would benefit from being more easy navigable, and from its figures being more easily visible. Given the immense size of Robbins, additional tools (beyond the Table of Contents and the word search function) for finding certain concepts would be very useful. Additionally, viewing the figures and pictures alters the interface in a detrimental fashion. That said, the benefits of having all of Robbins in such a small package instead of the incredibly heavy hard copy far outweigh any of the drawbacks inherent on putting it into an electronic format.
